By placing the focus on helping the riders, a real connection takes place that is difficult to explain. We encourage you to come, join our family, help others, and grow as a person.

At the Barn: When you arrive and leave the barn, we ask you to sign in and out with the time. We track the number of volunteer hours. There is a Volunteer Drawing bucket out during lessons and camps. On the desk top is a sign stating what the drawing for the week will be. Put your name on a ticket each time you come in. At the end of lessons or camp for the week someone will win the item or gift card.
